## SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (SAN DIEGO COUNTY) Nonfarm payrolls up 6,000 over the month; up 14,000 over the year

The unemployment rate in San Diego County was 4.1 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 4.4 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.

**Between March 2024 and April 2024,** total nonfarm employment increased from 1,556,700 to 1,562,700, a gain of 6,000 jobs. Agricultural employment added 600 jobs.

- Leisure and hospitality led month-over employment gains and recorded an increase of 2,600 jobs. The majority of this increase was seen in accommodation and food services, which bolstered its employment by 2,200. Arts, entertainment, and recreation rose by 400 jobs.
- Five additional sectors saw improvements in employment. Private education and health services increased by 1,800 jobs, with nearly 89 percent of the swell from health care and social assistance (up 1,600). Government also added 1,800 jobs, with local government alone contributing 1,300. Construction, financial activities, and trade, transportation, and utilities saw a combined increase of 1,300 jobs.
- Contrarily, three industry sectors saw month-over losses, contracting by a total of 1,500 jobs.
   Manufacturing saw the largest drop, falling by 800 jobs. Professional and business services declined by 500 jobs. The loss was recorded in administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (down 1,000), but was offset by a combined gain of 500 jobs in professional, scientific, and technical services and management of companies and enterprises. Information edged down by 200 jobs.

**Between April 2023 and April 2024,** total nonfarm employment increased by 14,000 and agricultural employment grew by 100.


- Leading the year-over advancements, private education and health services boosted its employment by 15,600 jobs. Health care and social assistance ramped up its employment by 13,700 jobs, contributing almost 88 percent of the growth in this sector. Private educational services also saw improvements, further strengthening employment by 1,900.
- Six other sectors also reported an upswing in employment, for a combined total of 15,300 jobs. The bulk of that employment was produced by leisure and hospitality (up 5,400) and government (up 5,200). The remaining 4,700 jobs came from construction, other services, trade, transportation, and utilities, and mining and logging.
- On the other hand, four sectors slowed the year-over growth by a total of 16,900 jobs. The majority of the losses were contributed by professional and business services (down 9,500), followed by manufacturing (down 4,100), financial activities (down 2,000), and information (down 1,300).
