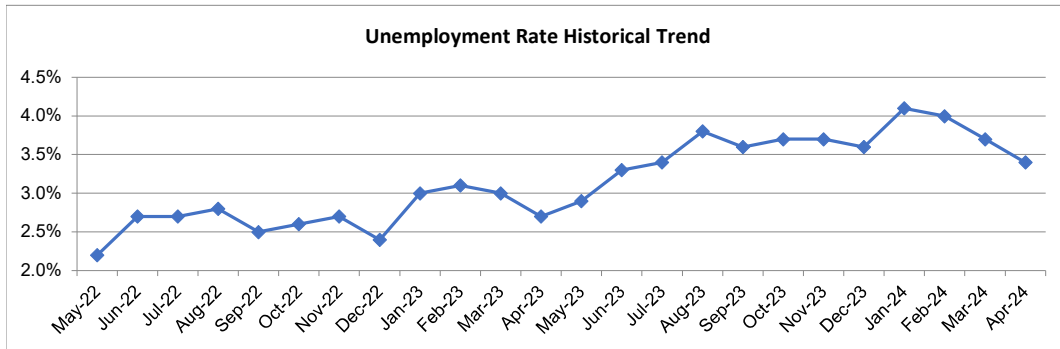

The unemployment rate in the Marin County was 3.4 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 3.7 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
