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Total job growth slows down; rose 0.1 percent over the month and year

The unemployment rate in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA was 3.9 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 4.2 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 6.7 percent in San Benito County, and 3.8 percent in Santa Clara County.

Between March 2024 and April 2024, total employment in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA, which also includes San Benito County, increased by 1,600 jobs to reach 1,160,600.

- Leisure and hospitality led month-over job gains by adding 1,800 positions. The bulk of the gains occurred in food services and drinking places (up 1,300 jobs).
- Professional and business services logged net payroll expansions of 900 jobs. All the gains were in administrative and support and waste management and remediation services.
- On the downside, government experienced overall losses of 1,300 jobs. In detail, local government excluding educational services lost 1,400 jobs and state government educational services picked up 100 jobs.
- While total farm gained 600 jobs, manufacturing dropped 600.
- The information sector cut 500 jobs from March to April.

Between April 2023 and April 2024, combined employment in the South Bay counties of San Benito and Santa Clara, rose by 1,200 jobs, or 0.1 percent.

- Private education and health services (up 11,200 jobs) dominated year-over job growth.
 Health care and social assistance added 9,000 jobs and private educational services increased by 2,200 jobs.
- Leisure and hospitality picked up 2,200 positions. Food services and drinking places (up 900 jobs) and accommodation (up 400) both had increases.
- Contrarily, information registered 6,500 job losses.
- Manufacturing also took a downturn, declining by 5,200 jobs from the previous year.
 Durable goods slashed 5,300 jobs, which was slightly offset by a small gain in non-durable goods (up 100 jobs).


