

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE BAKERSFIELD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Kern County)

The unemployment rate in Kern County was 9.3 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 10.2 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 8.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
