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LOS ANGELES-LONG BEACH-GLENDALE METROPOLITAN DIVISION (LOS ANGELES COUNTY) Nonfarm employment up 18,100 over the month and 32,600 over the year

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Los Angeles County was 5.3 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 5.4 percent in March 2024, and was above the rate of 4.8 percent one year ago. Civilian employment increased by 3,000 to 4,731,000 in April 2024, while unemployment decreased by 5,000 at 263,000. The civilian labor force decreased by 2,000 over the month to 4,994,000 in April 2024. (All of the above figures are seasonally adjusted.) The unadjusted unemployment rate for the county was 4.5 percent in April 2024.

The California seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.3 percent in April 2024, 5.3 percent in March 2024, and 4.5 percent a year ago in April 2023. The comparable estimates for the nation were 3.9 percent in April 2024, 3.8 percent in March 2024, and 3.4 percent a year ago.

Between March 2024 and April 2024, total nonfarm employment in Los Angeles County increased by 18,100 jobs to reach 4,577,300.

- Leisure and hospitality posted the largest month-over job advance (up 7,300) for its greatest month-over industry increase in twelve months. The gains were divided between accommodation and food services (up 3,800) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 3,500). Subsector payroll advances in food services and drinking places (up 3,400) and performing arts, spectator sports, and related industries (up 2,900) accounted for most of the growth.
- Private educational and health services added 6,600 jobs to reach its highest employment level on record. Health care and social assistance (up 4,700), which common occupations include registered nurses and medical assistants, accounted for more than two-thirds of the increase. Private educational institutions, which include postsecondary teachers and education administrators, added the remaining 1,900 jobs.
- Government payrolls were extended by 3,700. The job additions were driven up by local government (up 2,800) and centered around local government educational services (up 1,800). Local government excluding educational services (up 1,000), which includes police and sheriff patrol officers, also reported gains.
- Industries that saw month-over job declines include trade, transportation, and utilities (down 700), manufacturing (down 700), and professional and business services (down 500).

Between April 2023 and April 2024, Los Angeles County total nonfarm employment increased by 32,600 or 0.7 percent.

Private educational and health services (up 46,900) reported the largest year-over industry job
expansion. The healthcare needs of an aging population continue to drive up industry growth with
health care and social assistance accounting for more than three-quarters of progression adding
35,600 jobs. Private educational services further augmented the industry gains with an advance of
11,300 jobs.

- Public sector jobs in government were extended by 12,600. More than 94 percent of the job additions
 were driven up by local government (up 11,900) and centered around local government educational
 services (up 9,800), which includes public educators and teacher assistants.
- Leisure and hospitality saw payrolls expand by 8,900 jobs over the year. Employment additions in accommodation and food services (up 11,500) accounted for all the industry job gains that were led by food services and drinking places (up 10,200). The overall increase was offset by a job reduction in arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 2,600).
- Professional business services led in year-over job losses (down 17,100). Declines were evident in almost all industry sub-sectors and centered around administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (down 8,500) and professional, scientific, and technical services (down 8,100). Information reported additional job declines (down 14,500), with motion picture and sound recording industries (down 13,400) accounting for more than 90 percent of the job losses.
