OAKLAND-HAYWARD-BERKELEY METROPOLITAN DIVISION (MD) (ALAMEDA AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTIES) Government led the region in month-over job growth

The unemployment rate in the Oakland-Hayward-Berkeley MD was 4.7 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 5.0 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.6 percent in Alameda County, and 4.7 percent in Contra Costa County.

Between February 2024 and March 2024, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay counties of Alameda and Contra Costa increased by 5,400 to total 1,193,300.

- Government (up 1,900 jobs) generated the most jobs over the month. Boosts were in local government (up 1,500) and state government (up 400).
- Private education and health services attained a positive gain of 1,600 positions. Exactly seven-eighths of the uptick spawned from health care and social assistance (up 1,400 jobs).
- Construction experienced an increase of 1,200 jobs. Akin to last month, gains were produced in every category, specifically in specialty trade contractors (up 800 jobs).
- Meanwhile, trade, transportation, and utilities led the region in month-over job declines.
 Transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 600 jobs), retail trade (down 400), and wholesale trade (down 300) all registered with cutbacks.

Between March 2023 and March 2024, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay increased by 13,600 or 1.2 percent.

- Private education and health services (up 13,000 jobs) continued to demonstrate strong year-over job growth in the area for 15 consecutive months. Health care and social assistance (up 12,500) bolstered 96 percent of the industry total development.
- Government amplified hiring sector-wide by introducing 4,100 jobs over the year. Local government (up 3,700 jobs) contained ninety percent of the expansion.
- Leisure and hospitality advanced year-over employment by 2,100 jobs. Within the sector, arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 1,300 jobs) recovered the most opportunities.
- Conversely, manufacturing slashed the greatest number of payrolls throughout the year.
 Over ninety-one percent of the jobs were deducted from durable goods (down 3,100 jobs).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities (down 1,900 jobs), information (down 1,700), and financial activities (down 1,300) also encountered year-over declines.


