OAKLAND-HAYWARD-BERKELEY METROPOLITAN DIVISION (MD) (ALAMEDA AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTIES) Private education and health services carried month and year-over job expansion.

The unemployment rate in the Oakland-Hayward-Berkeley MD was 4.4 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 4.7 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.4 percent in Alameda County, and 4.4 percent in Contra Costa County.

Between March 2024 and April 2024, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay counties of Alameda and Contra Costa increased by 4,200 to total 1,197,000.

- Private education and health services (up 1,500 jobs) led the area in month-over gains. Health care and social assistance (up 1,400) was the main cause of the growth.
- Leisure and hospitality grew by 1,200 jobs. Food services and drinking places (up 700 jobs) accounted for 58 percent of the increase, while arts, entertainment, and recreation added 400 jobs and accommodation picked up 100 jobs.
- Professional and business services saw an uptick of 900 jobs. Professional, scientific, and technical services (up 600 jobs) made up over half of the expansion, while administrative and support and waste management and remediation services produced 400 jobs. Management of companies and enterprises (down 100) slightly offset the overall gains.
- On the other hand, manufacturing lost 1,000 jobs. Durable goods (down 800 jobs) was responsible for 80 percent of the decrease.

Between April 2023 and April 2024, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay increased by 9,800 or 0.8 percent.

- Private education and health services (up 12,700 jobs) has continued to trend upward. Health care and social assistance (up 12,200) continues to carry the industry's recovery.
- Government expanded by 4,600 jobs over the year. Local government (up 4,000 jobs) was a leading factor in the expansion, while state government added 400 jobs and federal government climbed by 200 jobs.
- On the downside, manufacturing cut back 4,200 jobs. Durable goods (down 3,600 jobs) accounted for around 86 percent of the downturn.
- Construction dropped 1,800 jobs while information dipped by 1,700 jobs.
- Trade transportation and utilities contracted by 1,500 jobs while leisure and hospitality added 1,500 jobs to its payrolls.


