ANAHEIM-SANTA ANA-IRVINE METROPOLITAN DIVISION (ORANGE COUNTY) Nonfarm jobs up 7,100 over the month and up 31,000 over the year

The unemployment rate in Orange County was 3.9 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 4.2 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between February 2024 and March 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,688,300 to 1,695,400, a gain of 7,100 jobs.

- Leisure and hospitality increased by 4,500 jobs, the largest expansion of any sector. Sixty-four percent of the gain was in arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 2,900 jobs). Accommodation and food services added 1,600 jobs.
- Employment increased in five other sectors. Private education and health services gained 1,700 jobs with 88 percent of the gain in health care and social assistance (up 1,500 jobs). Government added 1,300 jobs, construction and other services gained 500 jobs each, and information increased by 100 jobs.
- Four industry sectors had month-over employment declines. Three of the sectors
 declined by 400 jobs each: manufacturing, trade, transportation, and utilities, and
 financial activities. Professional and business services decreased by 300 jobs. Mining
 and logging had no change.


Between March 2023 and March 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 31,000 jobs, or 1.9 percent.

- Private education and health services led year-over gains with an increase of 15,600 jobs. Nearly 90 percent of the increase was in health care and social assistance (up 14,000 jobs). Private educational services added 1,600 jobs.
- Six other sectors contributed an additional 19,400 jobs: leisure and hospitality (up 7,100 jobs), government (up 4,200 jobs), professional and business services (up 3,100 jobs), construction (up 2,600 jobs), other services (up 2,200 jobs), and trade, transportation, and utilities (up 200 jobs).
- Three sectors contracted over the year: manufacturing (down 1,800 jobs), information (down 1,300 jobs), and financial activities (down 900 jobs). Mining and logging remained unchanged.
