ANAHEIM-SANTA ANA-IRVINE METROPOLITAN DIVISION (ORANGE COUNTY) Nonfarm jobs gained 2,400 over the month and 21,000 over the year

The unemployment rate in Orange County was 3.7 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 3.9 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between March 2024 and April 2024, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,693,400 to 1,695,800, a gain of 2,400 jobs.

- Private education and health services added 2,400 jobs, the most of any sector, with 88 percent of the increase in health care and social assistance (up 2,100 jobs). The remaining sectoral job growth was in private educational services (up 300 jobs).
- Five other sectors expanded, adding a total of 2,200 jobs. Trade, transportation, and utilities increased by 600 jobs. Financial activities, professional and business services, leisure and hospitality, and other services gained 400 jobs each.
- Three industry sectors contracted over the month: construction (down 1,400 jobs), manufacturing (down 600 jobs), and information (down 200 jobs).
- Government and mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between April 2023 and April 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 21,000 jobs, or 1.3 percent.


- Staffing levels increased in five sectors. Private education and health services gained the most, adding 16,000 jobs. Eighty-nine percent of the gain was in health care and social assistance (up 14,200 jobs). Private educational services added 1,800 jobs.
- Lesiure and hospitality was the second industry sector to add the most jobs over the year (up 5,000 jobs). Sixty-eight percent of the payroll gain was in arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 3,400 jobs). Accommodation and food services added 1,600 jobs.
- Employment declined in five other sectors: manufacturing (down 2,400 jobs), professional and business services (down 1,700 jobs), financial activities (down 1,600 jobs), information (down 1,400 jobs), and construction (down 100 jobs). Mining and logging had no change.
