

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE SANTA MARIA-SANTA BARBARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Santa Barbara County)

The unemployment rate in Santa Barbara County was 4.2 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 5.1 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
