# Initial Washington Green Economy Industry List E2SHB Implementation Team July 15, 2008

### **Legislative Direction**

Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill (E2SHB) 2815, passed in 2008, aims to make Washington's economy more sustainable and stimulate job creation in both established and emerging sectors of the "green economy." Section 09 of the bill directs Community, Trade, and Economic Development (CTED) to develop common definitions for "green economy" terms. It also directs the Employment Security Department (ESD) to survey industries to assess what "green jobs" already exist and levels of industry investment directed at preparing for new green jobs in the future.

#### **Green Economy Research**

CTED, named as the lead agency for many of E2SHB's task, and ESD, which is the lead agency for conducting the labor market survey, initiated a literature review and held a series of workgroup meetings on the topic. CTED lead Julie Anderson, and ESD lead, Greg Weeks, were assisted by Alan Hardcastle of Washington State University and several members of the research staff of the Labor Market and Economic Analysis Branch, ESD.

The research team reviewed literature from government, non-profit, business, and trade association sources from various parts of the country on the green economy, green industry, and green jobs/green collar jobs. Their research resulted in a first draft definition of green industries which includes renewable energy (including biofuels), energy efficiency, demand-response, green building and construction, recycling materials, and consulting and support industries. These broad industry categories are further defined in an initial green industry list organized by North American Industries Classification System (NAICS) code.

#### **Key Definitions**

The ESD labor survey team, together with CTED, has created the following key definitions that span the NAICS code listings:

The <u>Green Economy</u> is rooted in the development and use of products and services that promote environmental protection, energy independence, and economic development.

<u>Green Jobs</u> are jobs in the primary industries of a green economy that promote environmental protection and energy independence.

<u>Energy Independence</u> includes the development and use of energy efficiency and renewable energy products and services.

<u>Environmental Protection</u> includes the prevention and reduction of environmental pollution, as well as efforts to mitigate environmental pollution.
