

IMMEDIATE RELEASE MODESTO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Stanislaus County)

The unemployment rate in the Stanislaus County was 6.1 percent in May 2018, down from a revised 6.3 percent in April 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.7 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
