

**OAKLAND-HAYWARD-BERKELEY METROPOLITAN DIVISION (MD)
(ALAMEDA AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTIES)
Most major industries added jobs over the year**

The unemployment rate in the Oakland-Hayward-Berkeley MD was 4.1 percent in June 2017, up from a revised 3.4 percent in May 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.0 percent in Alameda County, and 4.2 percent in Contra Costa County.

Between May 2017 and June 2017, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay counties of Alameda and Contra Costa rose by 6,000 jobs to reach 1,161,500.

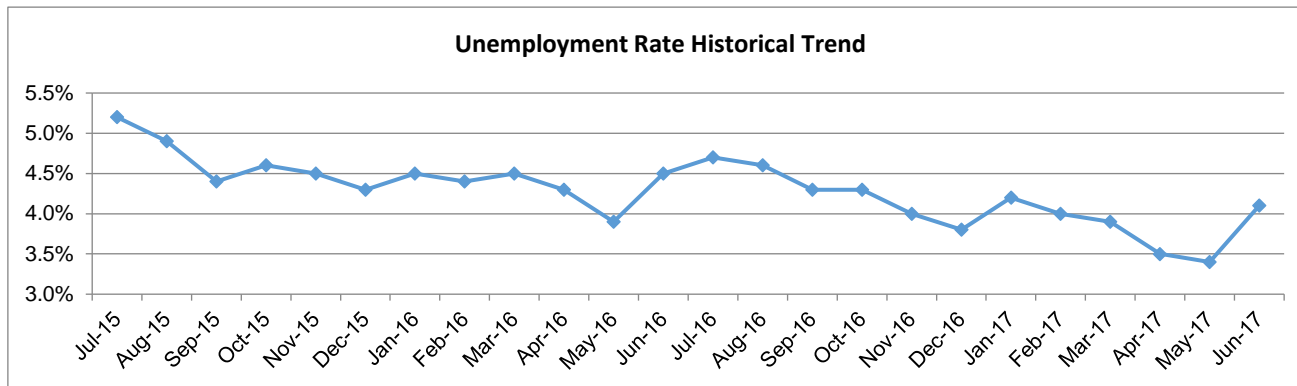
- Professional and business services added 3,300 jobs, far better than its average 800 job increase between May and June over the prior 10 years. Administrative and support and waste management services accounted for most of the gain (up 2,800 jobs).
- Leisure and hospitality expanded payrolls by 1,900 jobs. Food services and drinking places contributed over 50 percent of the increase, adding 1,000 jobs.
- Construction improved seasonally, adding 1,300 jobs over the month.
- Meanwhile, major industry groups reporting month-over declines included: government (down 1,300 jobs), and financial activities (down 400 jobs).

Between June 2016 and June 2017, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay increased by 26,500 jobs, or 2.3 percent.

- Professional and business services added 5,800 jobs, primarily within professional, scientific, and technical services (up 4,500 jobs).
- Private educational and health services advanced by 5,800 jobs. Health care and social assistance contributed to most of the gains (up 5,000 jobs).
- Other major industries with significant year-over additions included: government (up 5,400 jobs), construction (up 5,100 jobs), while leisure and hospitality, and financial activities added 1,800 jobs each.
- In contrast, manufacturing cut back 600 jobs over the year. The decline in durable goods (down 1,200 jobs), more than offset the increase of 600 jobs within non-durable goods.
