

**SACRAMENTO—ROSEVILLE—ARDEN-ARCADE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA  
(MSA)  
(EL DORADO, PLACER, SACRAMENTO, AND YOLO COUNTIES)  
Most major industries experienced job gains over the year**

The unemployment rate in the Sacramento--Roseville--Arden-Arcade MSA was 3.9 percent in March 2018, down from a revised 4.1 percent in February 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.2 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 3.8 percent in El Dorado County, 3.2 percent in Placer County, 3.9 percent in Sacramento County, and 4.8 percent in Yolo County.

**Between February 2018 and March 2018**, combined employment in the counties of El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, and Yolo increased by 600 to total 985,900 jobs.

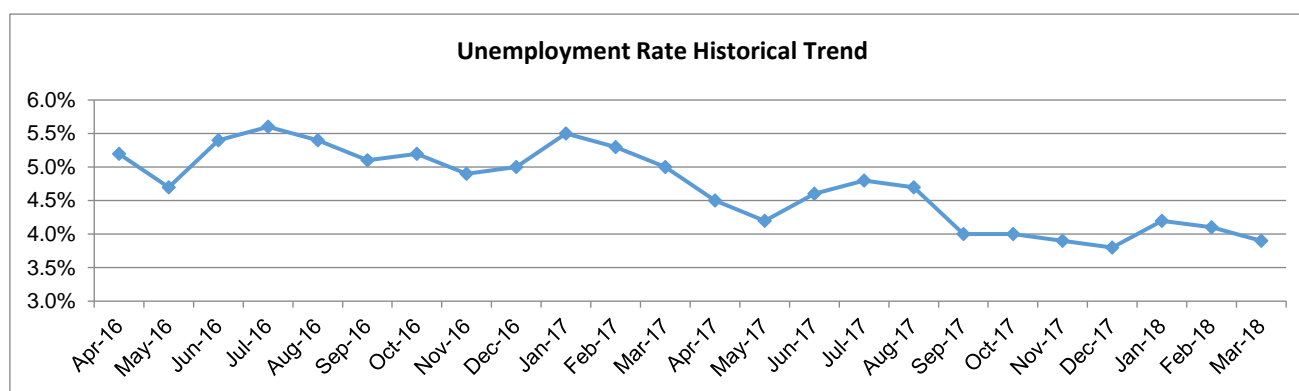
- Government (up 1,800 jobs) led the region in job growth from February to March. Local government accounted for 72.2 percent of the job additions, picking up 1,300 jobs.
- Leisure and hospitality expanded by 700 jobs. Accommodation and food services (up 700 jobs) was responsible for the expansion.
- Farm employment experienced a seasonal gain of 600 jobs.
- Meanwhile, six major industries reported month-over decline, led by construction (down 1,200 jobs), education and health services (down 1,000 jobs), and trade, transportation, and utilities (down 300 jobs).

**Between March 2017 and March 2018**, total jobs in the region increased by 20,000, or 2.1 percent.

- Education and health services led the year-over gains with an increase of 6,400 jobs. Health care and social assistance (up 5,400 jobs) accounted for 84.4 percent of the gains.
- Government advanced by 5,600 jobs. Local government gained 2,900 jobs. State government picked up 2,800 jobs.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities added 3,700 jobs since last March. Retail trade grew by 1,900 jobs. Wholesale trade gained 1,200 jobs. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities was up 600 jobs.
- Only three major industries experienced year-over job reductions: other services (down 1,000 jobs), information (down 600 jobs), and professional and business services (down 500 jobs).
