# SAN DIEGO-CALSBAD METROPOLITAN DIVISION (SAN DIEGO COUNTY) <u>Nonfarm employment reports job additions in ten of the last twelve months</u>

The unemployment rate in San Diego County was 4.7 percent in February 2024, unchanged from a revised 4.7 percent in January 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.6 percent for California and 4.2 percent for the nation during the same period.

**Between January 2024 and February 2024**, total nonfarm employment in San Diego County increased by 6,000 for a total of 1,551,900 jobs.

- Professional and business services reported a strong rebound from the previous month's decline of 3,600 jobs and led all industries with an addition of 3,100 jobs. More than a third of the month-over increase was concentrated around employment services (up 1,200), which supplies workers to businesses for limited periods of time. Professional, scientific, and technical services added an additional 900 jobs to help drive up the industry sector totals.
- Leisure and hospitality also reversed course and saw an employment increase of 2,500 jobs. The upturn was led by an addition of 1,800 jobs in accommodation and food services, most of which was centered around food services and drinking places (up 1,400). Arts, entertainment, and recreation widened the gains with an addition of 700 jobs.
- Private education and health services extended payrolls by 1,900 jobs. Health care and social assistance accounted for most of the increase (up 1,100). Continued job additions were reported across every health care subsector. Private educational services extended the overall industry job advance with an addition of 800 jobs.


**Between February 2023 and February 2024**, nonfarm employment in San Diego County increased by 13,600 or 0.9 percent.

- Private education and health services led the industry sectors in year-over growth adding 15,000 jobs. Health care and social assistance accounted for 91 percent of the employment development (up 13,600), with job gains reported across every health care subsector. Private educational services extended the increase with an addition of 1,400 jobs.
- Leisure and hospitality reported an increase of 6,100 jobs. The growth was led by a gain of 3,100 jobs in arts, entertainment, and recreation. This industry sub-sector led all nonfarm sub-sectors in annual percent change with an increase of 11 percent. Accommodation and food services contributed with an additional 3,000 jobs to the growth for a 1.8 percent year-over advancement.
- Government payrolls were up by 5,700 jobs. The bulk of the growth was driven up by job gains in local government (up3,600), with most of the increase centered in local government excluding educational services (up 2,200). State government contributed 2,200 jobs to the expansion, while federal government contracted by 100.
