### SAN DIEGO-CALSBAD METROPOLITAN DIVISION (SAN DIEGO COUNTY)

### Nonfarm employment reports seasonal declines and below-average year-over growth

The unemployment rate in San Diego County was 4.7 percent in January 2024, up from a revised 4.3 percent in December 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.

NOTE: Labor Force and Industry data contained in this release differ from previous information due to the U.S. Department of Labor's annual revision process.

**Between December 2023 and January 2024**, total nonfarm employment in San Diego County decreased by 23,400 for a total of 1,548,600 jobs.

- Trade, transportation, and utilities reported the largest month-over employment shift with a reduction of 7,300 jobs. Seasonal job declines were concentrated on retail trade (down 5,500), which accounted for seventy-five percent of the job losses. Additional declines in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (down 1,700), and wholesale trade (down 100), added to the overall reduction.
- Leisure and hospitality saw an employment decrease of 6,300 jobs. The contraction was led by a drop of 5,200 jobs in accommodation and food services, most of which was centered around food services and drinking places (down 4,100). Arts, entertainment, and recreation prolonged the losses with an additional reduction of 1,100 jobs.
- Professional and business services reported a decrease totaling 3,800 jobs. The bulk of the losses
  were in administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (down 1,900)
  and driven down by seasonal reductions in employment agencies (down 1,300). Professional,
  scientific, and technical services, an industry sub-sector associated with higher wage occupations,
  added to the overall decline, falling by 1,700 jobs.

**Between January 2023 and January 2024**, nonfarm employment in San Diego County increased by 20,500 or 1.3 percent.


- Private education and health services led the industry sectors in year-over growth and extended payrolls by 16,300 jobs. Health care and social assistance accounted for 91 percent of the increase (up 14,900). Gains were reported across every health care subsector with social assistance (up 6,900), which provides services to the elderly and disabled, leading the growth. Private educational services extended the increase with an addition of 1,400 jobs.
- Leisure and hospitality reported an increase of 6,700 jobs. The job advance was led by an addition of 3,700 jobs in accommodation and food services, specifically food services and drinking places (up 3,000). Arts, entertainment, and recreation added to the growth and posted an additional 3,000 jobs.
- Government payrolls were up by 4,300 jobs. The bulk of the job development was driven up by the return from the holiday break with public educational institutions within local government (up 2,100) and state government (up 2,000) accounting for most of the gain. Federal employment added 200 jobs to the annual growth.
