

**SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA
(SAN DIEGO COUNTY)**

Non-farm employment up 5,600 over the month and 32,500 over the year

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 2.9 percent in May 2018, unchanged from a revised 2.9 percent in April 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.7 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between April 2018 and May 2018, total non-farm employment increased from 1,480,200 to 1,485,800, adding 5,600 jobs. 100 jobs were added to farm employment, increasing to 9,100.

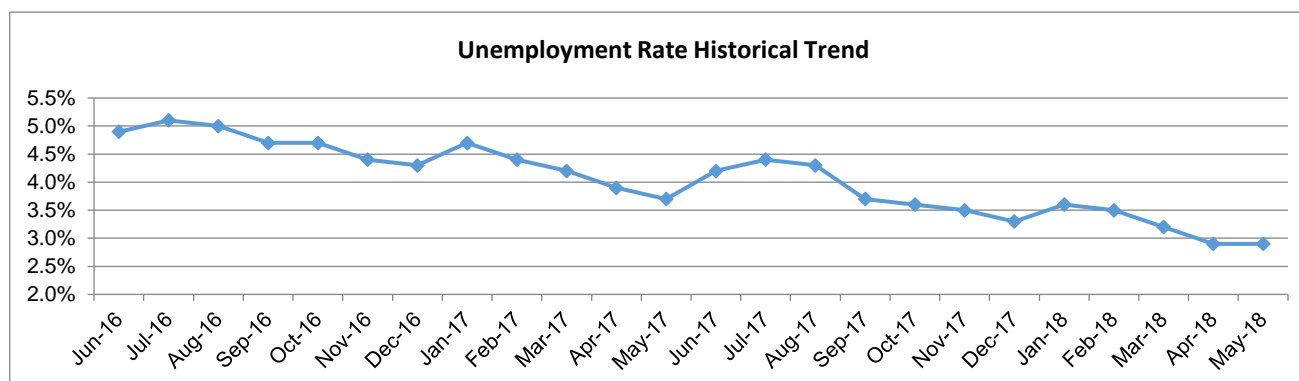
- Leisure and hospitality led all industry groups, expanding by 2,100 jobs over the month. Employment increases were spread across accommodation and food services (up 1,300) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 800).
- Trade, transportation and utilities recorded job gains of 900. Gains were led by higher than average April to May growth in wholesale trade (up 700), as well as an employment increase in retail trade (up 400). Employment in transportation and warehousing declined over the month (down 200).
- With two exceptions, all other super sectors recorded gains over the month. Professional and business services added 800 jobs. Construction employment grew by 600. Both government and financial activities gained 500 jobs. Employment in mining and logging remained stable.
- Educational and health services saw the only employment declines of any industry group, contracting by 300.

Between May 2017 and May 2018, total non-farm employment grew by 32,500, up from 1,453,300. Farm employment increased from 8,900 to 9,100, adding 200 jobs.

- Accounting for 48 percent of the county's job growth over the year, employment in professional and business services expanded by 15,500. Additions were spread across professional, scientific and technical services (up 8,600), administrative, support, and waste management (up 6,000), and management of companies and enterprises (up 900).
- Most other super sectors also recorded gains over the year, including construction (up 5,200), manufacturing (up 4,600), educational and health services (up 4,400), government (up 3,400), other services (up 1,900), trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,300), and information (up 300).
- Employment in leisure and hospitality was down 3,500 over the year. Declines were concentrated in accommodation and food services (down 3,100).
