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SAN FRANCISCO-REDWOOD CITY-SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO METROPOLITAN DIVISION (SAN FRANCISCO AND SAN MATEO COUNTIES) Information led the region in month-over and year-over job declines

The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD was 3.6 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 3.8 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in San Francisco County, and 3.5 percent in San Mateo County.

Between February 2024 and March 2024, the total number of jobs in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, increased by 1,300 jobs to total 1,157,900 jobs.

- Leisure and hospitality registered a leading month-over increase of 1,700 jobs. Over 76 percent of jobs were introduced by accommodation and food services (up 1,300 jobs), while arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 400) contributed the remaining 24 percent.
- Government recorded a comparable payroll gain of 1,500 jobs. Expansions in state government (up 900 jobs) and local government (up 700) outweighed the cut in federal government (down 100).
- Meanwhile, information (down 1,900 jobs) witnessed the largest month-over decrease among all major industries.
- Professional and business services experienced a net loss of 600 jobs. Despite
 additions from administrative and support and waste management and remediation
 services (up 800 jobs) and management of companies and enterprises (up 100),
 professional, scientific, and technical services curtailed 1,500 positions.

Between March 2023 and March 2024, the total number of jobs in the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo decreased by 12,600 jobs, or 1.1 percent.

- Information (down 13,000 jobs) has now led year-over decreases for five consecutive months, with losses reported across all the sub-sectors.
- Professional and business services (down 10,900 jobs) posted the second biggest yearover setback. Professional, scientific, and technical services (down 9,400) accounted for 86 percent of the slow-down, as management of companies and enterprises (down 1,200) made up another 11 percent.
- On the contrary, private education and health services rose by 7,400 jobs, which was the
 most significant increase over the year. Health care and social assistance (up 6,900
 jobs), social assistance (up 3,100), and private educational services (up 500) all
 continued to present robust growth.
- Notably, leisure and hospitality added 4,700 jobs and government imposed 3,700 jobs.


