

IMMEDIATE RELEASE SANTA MARIA-SANTA BARBARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Santa Barbara County)

The unemployment rate in Santa Barbara County was 5.7 percent in February 2024, unchanged from a revised 5.7 percent in January 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.6 percent for California and 4.2 percent for the nation during the same period.
