

**SAN JOSE-SUNNYVALE-SANTA CLARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(SAN BENITO AND SANTA CLARA COUNTIES)**
Leisure and hospitality led month-over job changes

The unemployment rate in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA was 2.3 percent in May 2018, down from a revised 2.4 percent in April 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.7 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.8 percent in San Benito County, and 2.3 percent in Santa Clara County.

Between April 2018 and May 2018, total employment in San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA, which also includes San Benito County, grew by 4,000 jobs to reach 1,133,400.

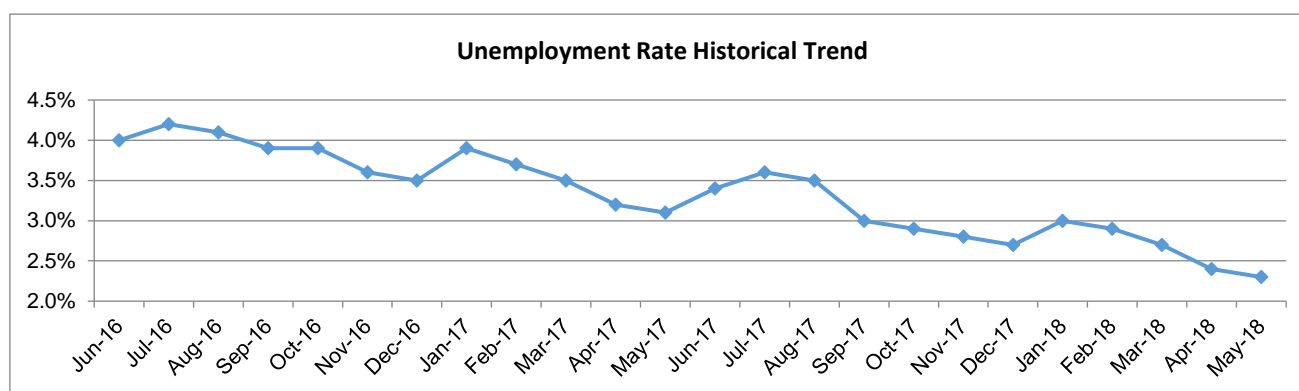
- Leisure and hospitality posted the largest job surge, adding 1,000 jobs to payroll.
- Professional and business services followed with increases of 700 jobs for the month of May.
- Private educational and health services as well as other services equally expanded with 600 jobs.
- Meanwhile, information reported a decrease of 600 jobs to payroll.

Between May 2017 and May 2018, combined employment in the South Bay counties of San Benito and Santa Clara expanded by 34,300 jobs, or 3.1 percent.

- Information led the yearly increases adding 8,000 jobs.
- Other major industry groups posting substantial gains over the year included: manufacturing (up 7,500 jobs), private educational and health services (up 7,300 jobs), professional and business services (up 6,000 jobs), leisure and hospitality (up 2,500 jobs), construction (up 2,500 jobs), and government (up 1,100 jobs).
- On the downside, trade, transportation, and utilities shed 600 jobs over the year.
