SAN JOSE-SUNNYVALE-SANTA CLARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (SAN BENITO AND SANTA CLARA COUNTIES) Total wage and salary slashed 19,100 jobs after holiday season ends

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The unemployment rate in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA was 4.4 percent in January 2024, up from a revised 4.0 percent in December 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 7.5 percent in San Benito County, and 4.3 percent in Santa Clara County.

<u>NOTE</u>: Labor Force and Industry data contained in this release differ from previous information due to the U.S. Department of Labor's annual revision process.

Between December 2023 and January 2024, total employment in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA, which also includes San Benito County, decreased by 19,100 jobs to reach 1,152,800.

- Trade, transportation, and utilities declined by 4,000 jobs due to the conclusion of the holiday season. Retail trade (down 3,000 jobs) accounted for most of the month-over employment losses.
- Private education and health services lost 2,800 jobs overall. Private educational services (down 1,900 jobs) dipped the most, followed by health care and social assistance (down 900).
- Leisure and hospitality also reduced its employment by 2,800 jobs; food services and drinking places took the largest hit (down 1,700 jobs).
- Other notable losses included: professional and business services (down 2,300 jobs), manufacturing (down 2,000) and construction (down 1,800).

Between January 2023 and January 2024, combined employment in the South Bay counties of San Benito and Santa Clara, decreased by 1,400 jobs, or 0.1 percent.


- Private education and health services expanded payrolls by 9,900 jobs, continuing to lead yearover gains for the eighth consecutive month. Health care and social assistance (up 8,400 jobs) had the largest uptick.
- Government advanced by 2,700 jobs. Local government excluding educational services (up 1,800 jobs) made up for about 67 percent of the gains.
- On the downside, both information and professional and business services experienced declines of 6,400 positions each.
