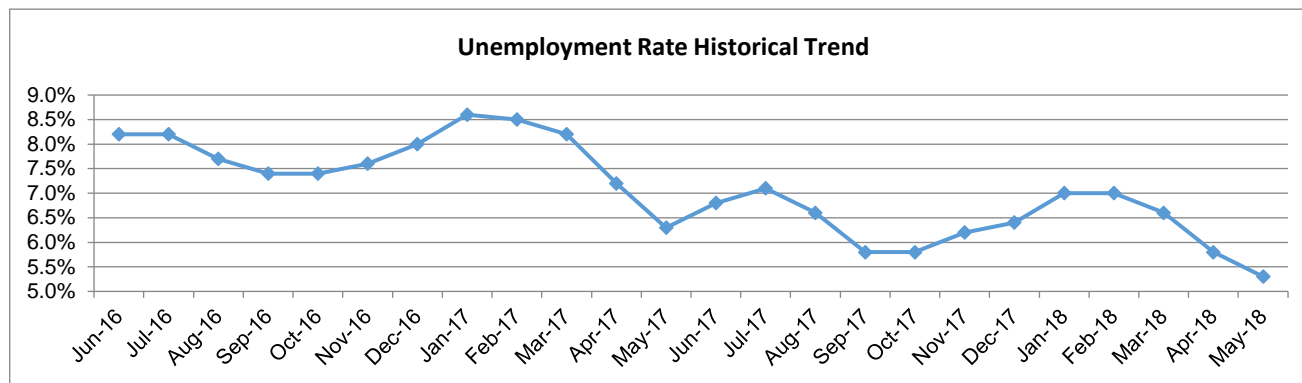


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 5.3 percent in May 2018, down from a revised 5.8 percent in April 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.7 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
