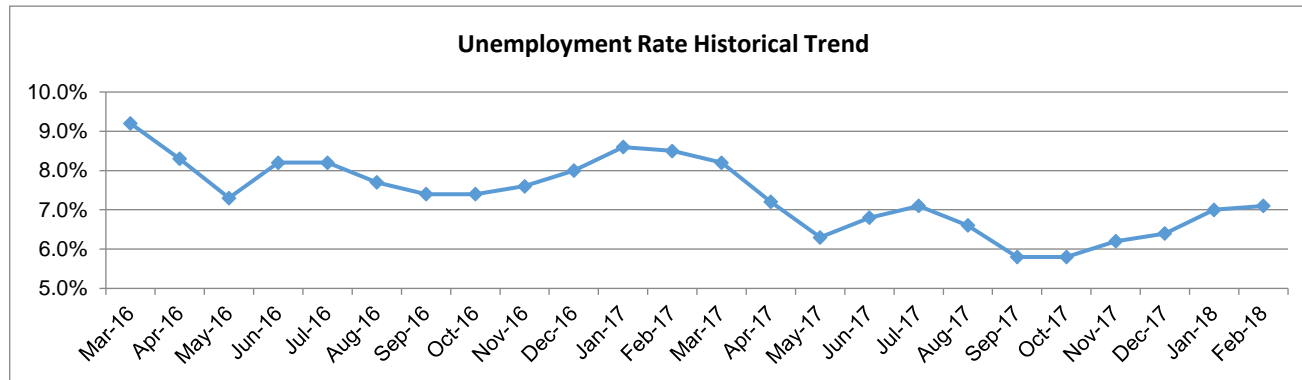


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 7.1 percent in February 2018, up from a revised 7.0 percent in January 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.5 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
