

IMMEDIATE RELEASE CHICO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Butte County)

The unemployment rate in the Butte County was 6.8 percent in February 2024, up from a revised 6.6 percent in January 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.6 percent for California and 4.2 percent for the nation during the same period.
