FRESNO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (FRESNO COUNTY) Private education and health services increased by 3,800 over the year

The unemployment rate in Fresno County was 9.1 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 9.6 percent in February 2024, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between February 2024 and March 2024, total industry employment decreased by 1,000 jobs (down 0.2 percent), to total 425,000. Nonfarm employment rose by 2,000 jobs (up 0.5 percent), while farm employment dropped by 3,000 jobs (down 8.3 percent).


- Farm employment posted the largest month-over decline with a decrease of 3,000 jobs.
- Two industry sectors reported employment reductions of 100 jobs each: trade, transportation, and utilities and financial activities.
- Meanwhile, private education and health services moved up by 500 jobs. Health care and social assistance increased by 400 jobs and private educational services rose by 100 jobs.
- Construction added 500 jobs over the month.
- Professional and business services experienced a job uptick of 400 jobs and leisure and hospitality gained 300 jobs.

Between March 2023 and March 2024, total industry employment increased by 12,100 jobs (up 2.9 percent). Nonfarm employment rose by 11,000 jobs (up 2.9 percent), and farm employment added 1,100 jobs (up 3.4 percent).

- Private education and health services posted the largest year-over increase of 3,800 jobs. Health care and social assistance increased by 4,000 jobs, while private educational services fell by 200 jobs.
- Government expanded payrolls by 3,600 jobs. Gains were in local government (up 3,200 jobs), state government (up 300 jobs), and federal government (up 100 jobs).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities climbed up by 1,400 jobs. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities increased by 800 jobs, retail trade grew by 500 jobs, and wholesale trade added 100 jobs.
- Farm employment reported an increase of 1,100 jobs.
- Construction recorded a payroll growth of 1,100 jobs. Specialty trade contractors accounted for 82 percent of the job gain (up 900 jobs).
