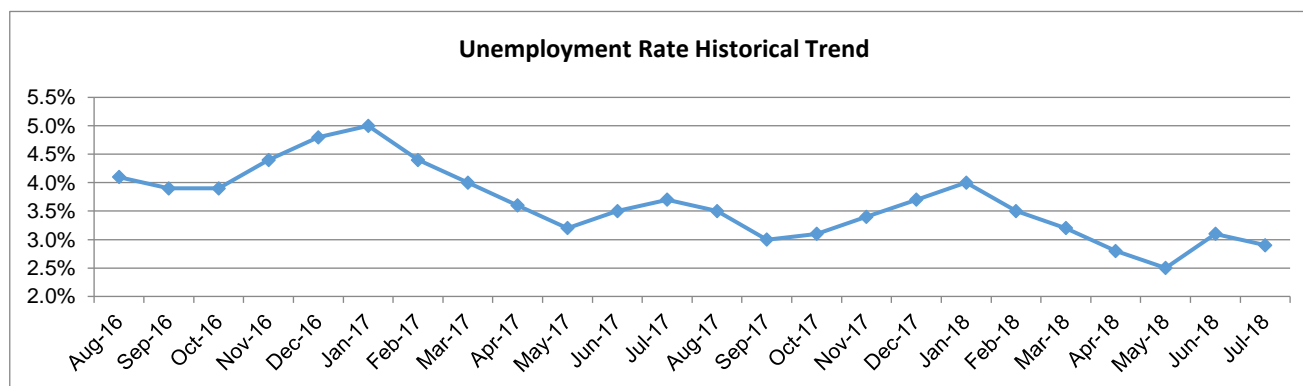


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 NAPA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Napa County)

The unemployment rate in the Napa County was 2.9 percent in July 2018, down from a revised 3.1 percent in June 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.4 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
