Orange County loses 10,100 nonfarm jobs over the month; gains 16,000 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Orange County was 3.2 percent in July 2018, down from a revised 3.3 percent in June 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.4 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between June 2018 and July 2018, total nonfarm employment declined from 1,635,600 to 1,625,500, a decrease of 10,100 jobs.

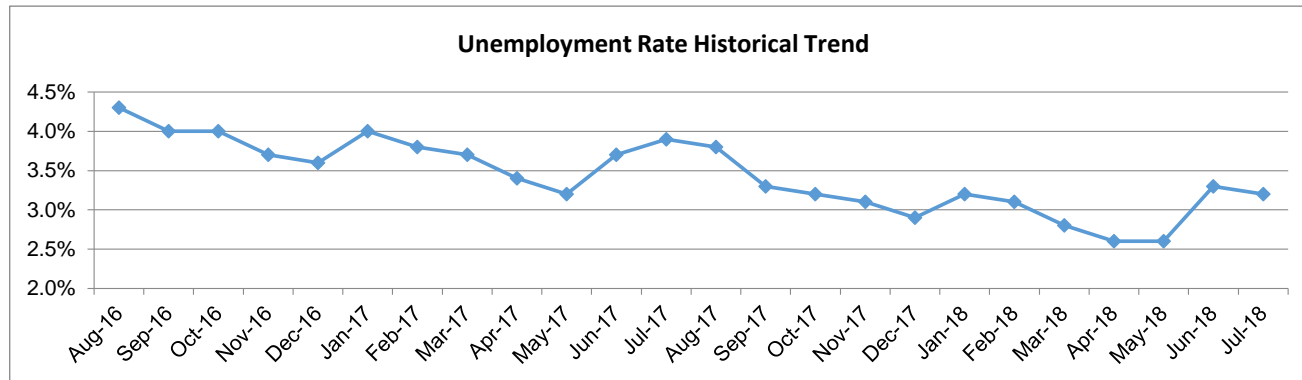
- Government reported the largest month-over decline of 12,300 jobs. The majority of the loss was in local government (down 9,600 jobs), due to the summer recess. State government reported a drop of 2,800 jobs, with all the loss in state government education. Federal government increased by 100 payroll jobs.
- Educational and health services declined by 1,900 jobs over the month. A drop of 2,700 jobs in educational services was offset by an employment increase of 800 jobs in healthcare and social assistance.
- Two other sectors recorded payroll losses: other services (down 1,100 jobs) and financial activities (down 600 jobs).
- Six sectors reported payroll increases with professional and business services adding the most jobs (up 2,000). Fifty five percent of the gain was in professional, scientific and technical services. Mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between July 2017 and July 2018, total nonfarm employment increased by 16,000 jobs, or one percent.

- Educational and health services reported the largest increase over the year, with the addition of 8,300 jobs. Eighty percent of the gain was health in care and social assistance (up 6,800 jobs) followed by advances in ambulatory health care services.
- Professional and business services posted an overall increase of 8,100 jobs. Over 90 percent of the gain was in administrative and support services, which includes temporary help firms.
- Manufacturing reported the largest year over payroll decline of 4,100 jobs. Approximately 60 percent of the loss was reported in durable goods (down 2,600 jobs) while nondurable goods decreased by 1,500 jobs. Mining and logging reported no change.
