ANAHEIM-SANTA ANA-IRVINE METROPOLITAN DIVISION (ORANGE COUNTY) Orange County loses 24,700 jobs over the month; gains 28,600 jobs over the year

The unemployment rate in Orange County was 4.2 percent in January 2024, up from a revised 3.8 percent in December 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.7 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.

<u>NOTE</u>: Labor Force and Industry data contained in this release differ from previous information due to the U.S. Department of Labor's annual revision process.

Between December 2023 and January 2024, total nonfarm employment declined from 1,707,800 to 1,683,100, a decrease of 24,700 jobs.

- Trade, transportation, and utilities decreased the most of any sector, losing 6,800 jobs. Retail trade (down 5,500 jobs) led the contraction, accounting for 81 percent of the decrease, followed by a drop of 1,400 jobs in transportation, warehousing, and utilities. The losses were offset by a gain of 100 jobs in wholesale trade.
- Leisure and hospitality had the second largest employment decline (down 6,200 jobs). Eighty-one percent of the drop was in accommodation and food services (down 5,000 jobs) led by payroll declines in food services and drinking places (down 4,500 jobs). Arts, entertainment, and recreation decreased by 1,200 jobs.
- Eight other industry sectors contracted, contributing the remaining 11,700 jobs lost. Mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between January 2023 and January 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 28,600 jobs, or 1.7 percent.


- Private education and health services (up 17,200 jobs) made-up 60 percent of the total nonfarm year-over increase. The bulk of the employment expansion was in health care and social assistance (up 14,700 jobs). Private educational services increased by 2,500 jobs.
- Five other sectors expanded, adding a total of 16,400 jobs: leisure and hospitality (up 5,000 jobs), construction (up 4,000 jobs), government (up 3,600 jobs), other services (up 2,200 jobs), and trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,600 jobs).
- Four industry sectors declined over the year, losing a total of 5,000 jobs: professional and business services (down 2,500 jobs), information (down 1,500 jobs), financial activities (down 900 jobs), and manufacturing (down 100 jobs). Mining and logging had no payroll changes.
