

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE REDDING METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Shasta County)

The unemployment rate in the Shasta County was 4.8 percent in December 2021, down from a revised 4.9 percent in November 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 3.7 percent for the nation during the same period.
