Professional business and services led year-over expansion

The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD was 2.3 percent in August 2022, up from a revised 2.1 percent in July 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.1 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 2.3 percent in San Francisco County, and 2.1 percent in San Mateo County.

Between July 2022 and August 2022, the total number of jobs in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, decreased by 1,600 jobs to total 1,182,900 jobs.

- Professional and business services and other services contracted by 1,800 jobs each, posting the largest employment decrease among the major industries. Professional, scientific, and technical services (down 1,900) and religious, grantmaking, civic, professional, and similar organizations (down 1,600) were responsible for the payroll decrease.
- Construction dwindled by 700 jobs. Specialty trade contractors (down 600) and construction of buildings (down 100) accounted for the employment loss.
- Leisure and hospitality (up 1,600) registered payroll advances with increases in accommodation and food services (up 1,600 jobs). Food and drinking places (up 1,000) and accommodation (up 600) contributed to the job expansion.
- Private educational and health services produced 900 jobs. Health care and social assistance (up 900) contributed to the job gain.

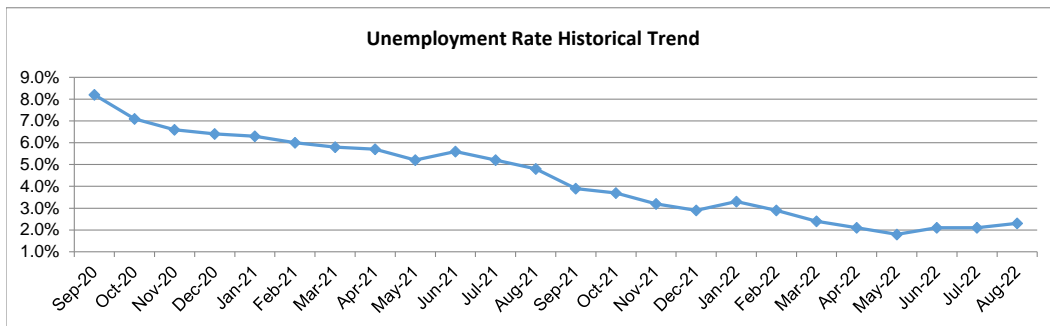
Between August 2021 and August 2022, the total number of jobs in the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo increased by 69,200 jobs, or 6.2 percent.

- Professional and business services (up 27,300) led year-over employment gains with advances in professional, scientific, and technical services (up 25,700), administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (up 1,300), and management of companies and enterprises (up 300).
- Leisure and hospitality produced 15,700 jobs with employment increases in accommodation and food services (up 13,400) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 2,300). Within accommodation and food services, food services and drinking places (up 10,600) contributed to about 79 percent of the payroll growth.
- Information (up 7,500), trade, transportation, and utilities (up 6,000), and construction (up 4,700) all boosted payrolls.
- Other services climbed by 4,200 jobs. Personal and laundry services and religious, grantmaking, civic, professional, and similar organizations contributed to the job increase by 1,700 jobs each.
