

IMMEDIATE RELEASE SANTA MARIA-SANTA BARBARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Santa Barbara County)

The unemployment rate in Santa Barbara County was 5.1 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 5.8 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
