

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE SANTA MARIA-SANTA BARBARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Santa Barbara County)

The unemployment rate in the Santa Barbara County was 3.3 percent in September 2018, down from a revised 3.6 percent in August 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.9 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
