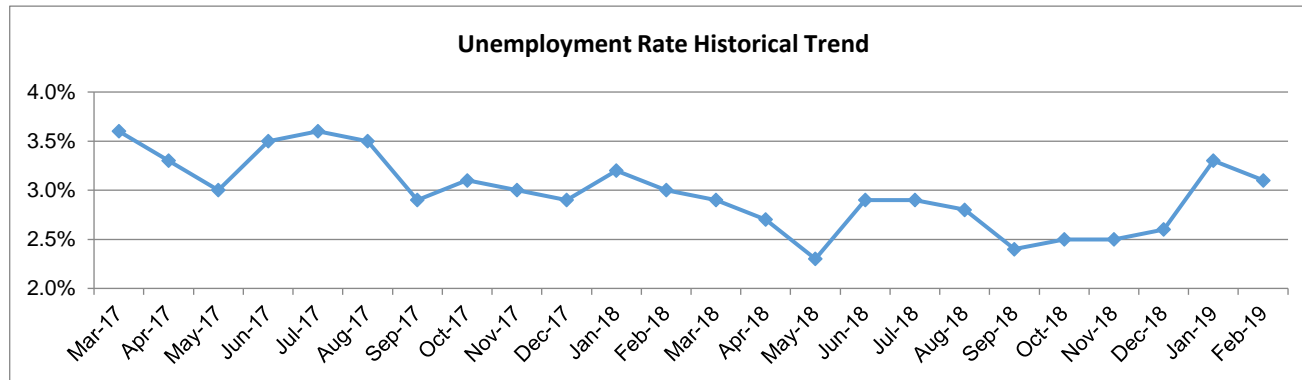


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 SANTA ROSA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Sonoma County)

The unemployment rate in the Sonoma County was 3.1 percent in February 2019, down from a revised 3.3 percent in January 2019, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.4 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
