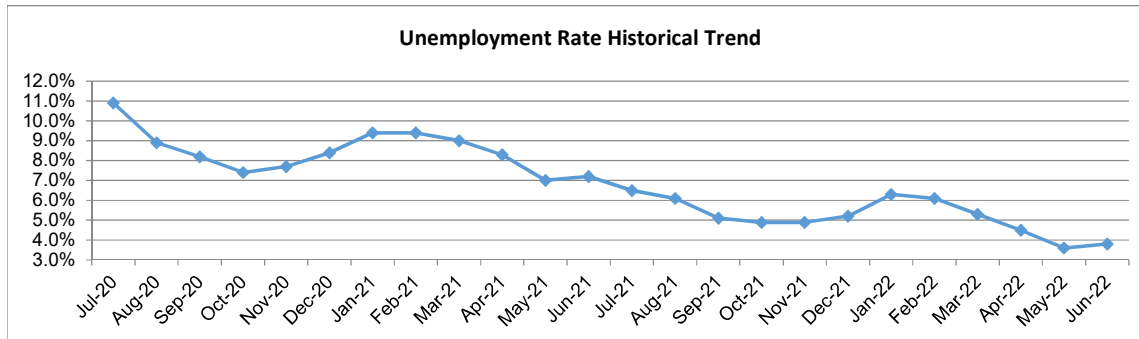


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 SANTA CRUZ-WATSONVILLE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Santa Cruz County)

The unemployment rate in the Santa Cruz County was 3.8 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 3.6 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
