

IMMEDIATE RELEASE

SAN LUIS OBISPO-PASO ROBLES-ARROYO GRANDE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (San Luis Obispo County)

The unemployment rate in San Luis Obispo County was 4.0 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 4.4 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
