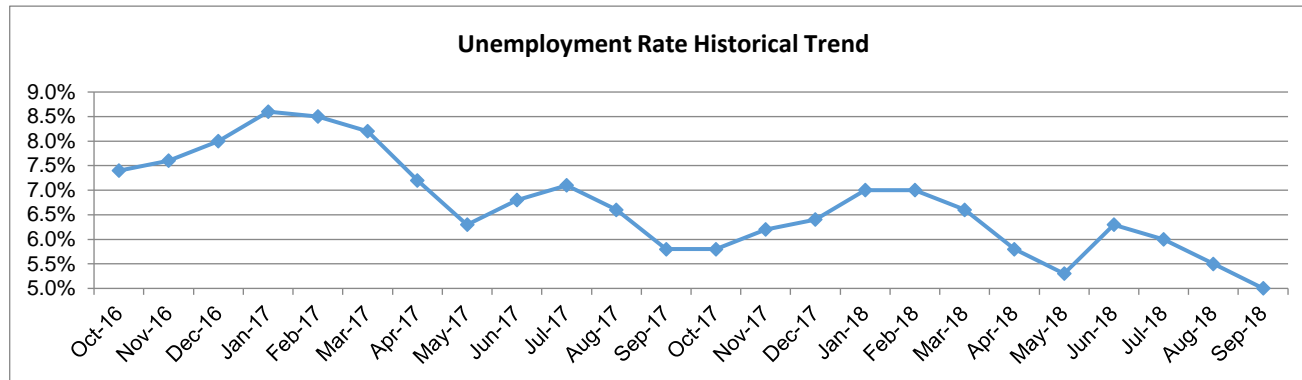


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 5.0 percent in September 2018, down from a revised 5.5 percent in August 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.9 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
