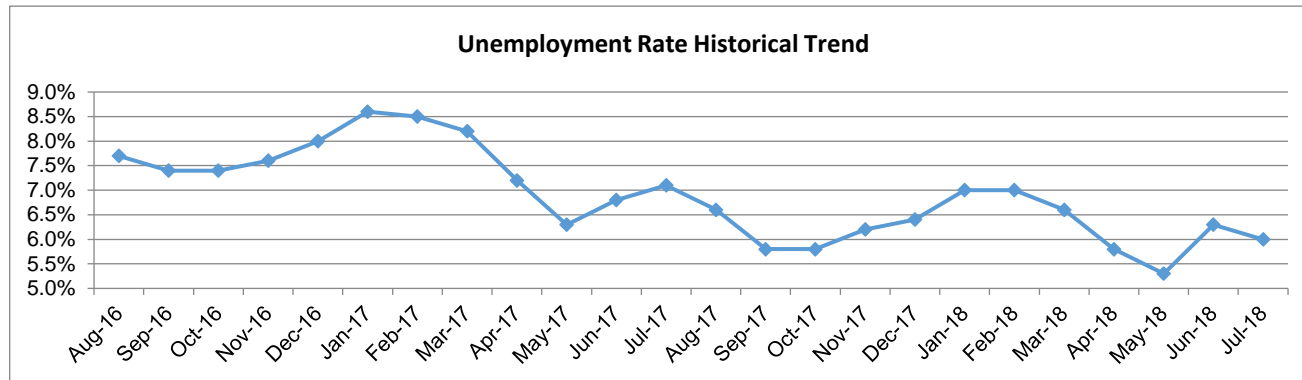


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 6.0 percent in July 2018, down from a revised 6.3 percent in June 2018, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.4 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
