

IMMEDIATE RELEASE STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 7.1 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 7.7 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
