

IMMEDIATE RELEASE VALLEJO-FAIRFIELD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Solano County)

The unemployment rate in the Solano County was 5.3 percent in March 2024, down from a revised 5.7 percent in February 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
