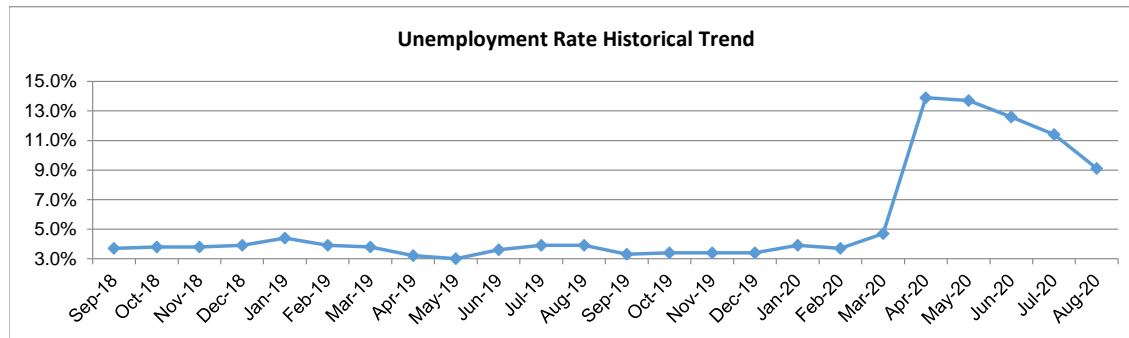


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 OXNARD-THOUSAND OAKS-VENTURA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Ventura County)

The unemployment rate in the Ventura County was 9.1 percent in August 2020, down from a revised 11.4 percent in July 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 11.6 percent for California and 8.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
